



"Model United Nations" is a simulation of the United Nations where the official rules of the organization and some of its official Committees are being simulated (for example, the Security Council and the Human Rights Council, etc.).

Participants are assigned a different country and for the duration of the conference, and they represent the country's official policies and defend them on different global issues, depending on the Committee they are part of.

In order to do this, you need to research the policy of the country you are representing. This includes making a research not only on the official policies of this country, but also on its specific policies on given topics (the ones that you will discuss in your particular Committee), so you are able to react in an appropriate manner to any questions regarding to the policy of your country.
